



Dress Code 2026-2027

Tiny Tots Ballet Class

Dancers should wear Capezio Ballet Pink tights, light pink leotards, and canvas ballet pink ballet shoes; a pink ballet skirt is optional.

PK Groove

Dancers should wear moveable clothing. No shoes are required.

Creative Movement

Dancers should wear Capezio Ballet Pink tights, light pink leotards, canvas ballet pink ballet shoes, and shiny, black tap shoes with velcro (see tap section); a pink ballet skirt is optional. Hair should be neatly pulled back in a ballet bun.

Jazz

Dancers should wear tight-fitting clothing with hair neatly pulled back. Dancers in Mini Jazz should wear nude jazz shoes (pictured right). Jazz I-IV may wear pirouette shoes, foot undies, or may go barefoot; they will be barefoot for the Spring Show. Dancers should not wear socks.



Jazz/Leaps & Turns

Dancers should wear leggings or bike shorts and a tight fitting tank top, no loose clothing or skirts with hair neatly pulled back. Dancers may wear pirouette shoes, foot undies, or go barefoot. Dancers should not wear socks.

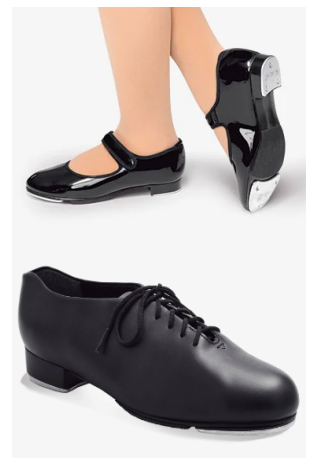
Hip-Hop

Dancers should wear loose-fitting clothing (sweatpants, t-shirts, leggings, sweatshirts) and tennis shoes.

Tap

Dancers should wear tight-fitting clothing and black tap shoes with hair neatly pulled back in a bun or ponytail.

- **Tiny Tots-Mini** - Shiny, Black, Mary-Jane Tap Shoes with velcro (pictured on top)
- **Level I-IV** - Matte, Black Tap Shoes, no split sole (pictured on bottom)



Ballet

Ballet I-IV should wear Capezio Ballet Pink tights, Capezio Canvas Ballet Pink ballet shoes, and the appropriate color leotard for their level; Tiny Tots-Mini Dancers should wear canvas ballet pink ballet shoes, Capezio Ballet Pink tights, and the appropriate color leotard for their level. A matching color ballet skirt is optional but shorts may not be worn. Hair should be neatly pulled back in a ballet bun without wispies or long bangs.

- **Tiny Tots-Petites** – Light Pink Leotard
- **Minis** – Light Purple Leotard
- **Level I** – Baby Blue Leotard
- **Level II** – Royal Blue Leotard
- **Level III** – Navy Blue Leotard
- **Level IV** – Black Leotard

Contemporary

Dancers should wear tight-fitting clothing with hair neatly pulled back. Dancers may wear pirouette shoes or foot undies for turning, or may go barefoot. Dancers should not wear socks.

Musical Theatre

Dancers should wear tight-fitting clothing with hair neatly pulled back. Dancers may wear skin-toned jazz shoes, pedini shoes, or character shoes. Character shoes or jazz shoes may be required for the Spring Show; the specific style and color will be announced after Christmas Break if applicable. Do not purchase shoes for Musical Theatre unless directed by the instructor.

Power Classes (*Applicable for Strength & Conditioning*)

Dancers are required to wear sticky socks for every pilates class. Dancers who forget their sticky socks will be required to purchase a pair of sticky socks; the account holder will be charged.

Break in Dress Code Expectations - Dancers who forget the necessary hair supplies for class should go to the office where they can purchase a small pack of hair supplies to keep in their dance bag; the account holder will be charged \$1.50 for this hair supply kit. Dancers who forget their required dance attire, after two grace periods, will be required to purchase what they need from the office; the account holder will be charged for any necessary dance attire.
